

POLICY CONCERNING WAIVER OF INITIAL HEARINGS

Based upon the current corona virus crisis and the order of Governor Holcomb, defendants who are represented by counsel and not in custody may file a motion to waive an Initial Hearing that is scheduled from now until April 7, 2020. The motion must be filed by the attorney and indicate that counsel has advised the client of the charges, penalty range and constitutional rights.
