### **Notice of Judicial Opening and Application Due Date**

The Lake County Judicial Nominating Commission is beginning the process of selecting a new Superior Court judge. A vacancy on the Lake Superior Court, Criminal Division, Room 2 that sits in Crown Point, Indiana will occur on January 1, 2021, since Judge Clarence Murray is not seeking retention. Selection for this position will be in compliance with the provisions of IC Chapter 33-33-45. Any person who is domiciled in Lake County, is a citizen of the United States, and is admitted to the Practice of Law in Indiana, is eligible to apply for this position.

Completed applications must be submitted by 12 p.m. CDT, Monday, September 21, 2020. Applications must be submitted electronically through the Indiana Courts Portal at <http://portal.courts.in.gov>.
