

Emergency Pandemic Protocols
UPDATES JANUARY 27, 2021
Lake Superior Court, Criminal Division

Based upon the pandemic metrics issued by the Indiana State Department of Health, as of January 27, 2021, Lake County is in the Orange Zone but our metrics and positivity rates remain concerning. Therefore, effective immediately, the Court accepts the recommendations suggested by Governor Eric Holcomb, ISDH, and the Resuming Court Operations Task Force, and will continue the local existing emergency protocols until at least Friday, February 26, 2021, as follows:

There will be no jury trials.

All hearings will be held remotely with the exception of some initial hearings and hearings on Petitions to Revoke Probation for individuals who have posted bond as indicated by Orders of the Magistrates. The in-person calls will be held at the usual times, but will be held remotely. The in-custody calls will also be held at their usual times, and will continue to be held via Zoom. Properly executed written waivers must be filed prior to the proceedings. As an exception to this rule, emergency hearings may be held in court if they cannot be held remotely, only if specifically authorized by the Court, upon proper motion filed, and the only people who will be allowed in the courtroom besides Court staff will be the Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, the Defense Attorney, the Defendant, and any essential witnesses.
